

**Fulton County FRESH and Human Services Grant's
Reviewer Technical Assistance Analysis
February 15, 22, and 23rd 2011**

The Fulton County Office of Community Partnerships hosted Grant Reviewer Technical Assistance Workshops on February 15, February 22, and February 23, 2011. During the workshops, the 2011 grant application review process for FRESH and Human Services were explained and questions were answered.

A survey was developed utilizing Survey Monkey and was emailed to all attendees. Twelve surveys were sent out after the technical assistance workshop was hosted on February 15; six responded. The second set of surveys were sent out after the next workshop which was hosted on February 22. At that time, 8 were emailed out and 1 response was received. The last survey was sent after the third and final workshop occurred on February 23. At that time, 16 were sent out and 3 responses were received. The low response rate could have been due to the short amount of time given for the survey return.

The following pages visually depict feedback from the surveys based on the day the individual attended a workshop.



There was only one response to the above survey. As you can see, the categories that were chosen were "agree" and "strongly agree".


